Term 4 Learn to Swim Newsletter

Term 4 is quickly coming to an end, 2023 is almost over! Last lessons for Term 4 are Saturday 16th December.

Term 1 2024 – POOL UPGRADE

As you would be aware, the tiles in the 25m pool desperately need repairing. A contract has been awarded by CGSC to Upgrade the 25m pool. The tiles are almost 25 years old and are at the end of their life. The upgrade will see the tiles and pool concourse removed and replaced.

To enable this project to be carried out, the pool hall will be closed for approximately 10 weeks, from March 4th 2024.

This means our Term 1 program will run for 5 weeks prior to the closing date.

Enrolments are now open for TERM 1!

Term 1 will begin Monday 29th January and conclude Saturday 2nd March.

Watch Around Water Policy Reminder: Your child, Your Focus



If your child is under 5 years of age,
you must be within arm's reach of you child at all times.

Children under 10 must be actively supervised by a
parent or guardian and must be in line of sight at all times. This
includes during swimming lessons, even when children are un-
der the guidance of swim teaches.

Children 10 years and over who are deemed competent to swim
and behave appropriately are able to swim without a parent/
guardian.

All levels and abilities are welcome. From the timid student through to our most advanced students, this program is suitable for all. Kids who live or do lessons elsewhere are also invited to join this program.

Reminders:

SCAN Membership Cards please don't forget to scan your child's card each time you attend their lesson. Lots of families are just walking straight through but scanning isn't optional—we need this to record attendance.

We realise sometimes you forget your card—please let staff know at the front desk and they will sign you in. Let us know if you have lost the card and need a new one. Purple cards can also be used for free swimming at anytime during the Term for extra practice and fun in the water. One adult admission is included for free for children under 3.

Absence: If you are unable to make your lesson please give us a call to notify us so teachers can be aware and alter lesson plans as required.

A reminder, missed lessons will be forfeited unless a doctor's certificate is provided. This includes private lessons without 24 hours notice. A credit will be provided for your next term of swimming where applicable.

Private lesson absences must be notified so the message can be passed onto teachers. Repeated failure to do so may forfeit your private lesson spot next term.
